To Whom It May Concern,

This letter is to introduce Mr. Gregory A. Martin. Mr. Martin is a senior Certified Examiner with the Computer Voice Stress Analyzer (CVSA). The CVSA is an investigative tool used by approximately 1,800 US law enforcement agencies to detect, measure and quantify stress or the lack of stress produced by the human voice associated with truth or deception. The CVSA is the only voice stress analysis system in the world that incorporates two US Patents, numbers 7,321,855 and 7,571,10. The CVSA was designed and developed by the National Institute for Truth Verification (NITV), which has been in business for 23 years, and the NITV is the sole source of the CVSA. In addition to US law enforcement, the CVSA is also used by US Federal Agencies, the US Military and a number of foreign police, security and intelligence services. There are currently over 5,000 Certified CVSA Examiners worldwide. Further, CVSA training is recognized by the State of Missouri, Department of Public Safety, Missouri Peace Officer Standards and Training (POST) Program.

Mr. Martin is also a member of the Board of Directors for the National Association of Computer Voice Stress Analysts (NACVSA). The NACVSA is the only professional development and certification organization for CVSA Examiners, and has approximately 1,000 members.

Since he became a Certified Examiner in 2001, the NITV has had the honor of working very closely with Mr. Martin. He is one of the most knowledgeable CVSA Examiners in the world, and his professional standards and reputation are beyond reproach.
